

Our Wildlife Rehab Patients Need Your Help...



The goal of the Brukner Nature Center Wildlife Rehablitiation Center is to educate people regarding the natural history of Ohio's wild-

life, to offer help and advice when wildlife and people conflict, and to care for, rehabilitate and release native Ohio wildlife expected to survive in the natural environment. When you donate to the 'Adopt-a-Release Box' program at Brukner Nature Center, these wooden boxes will help with the release of healthy wildlife babies and adults when they are ready to be on their own.

Why are these release boxes important to wildlife? Animals attracted to cavities such as squirrels, Virginia opossums and a variety of passerines are provided with a release box to help simulate a more natural environment during their recovery process. Over time, a release box becomes a place to establish a cache of food to eat throughout the year or even provides shelter from predators, weather or simply a place to rest - just like natural cavities in the wild. For many juvenile animals this is their first home when released back into the wild!

Your support of our "Adopt-a-Release-Box" program will help us to continue to provide hundreds of wildlife rehab patients with the support they need as they return to the wild. How cool is that?!

- Over 1,000 wild patients are admitted to our Wildlife Rehabiliation Unit each year!
- Although many of the wildlife arrive with very serious conditions, we have a successful release rate average of 35%!
- Our Wildlife Rehabilitation Unit receives over 80 different species of wildlife each year! A large majority of the wildlife are orphaned baby squirrels!
- Caring individuals from over 20 Ohio counties bring injured or orphaned wildlife to Brukner Nature Center each year!
- Numerous volunteers help with the cleaning and feeding of the wildlife patients in our Wildlife Rehabiliation Unit!
- The busy season for our Wildlife Rehabilitation Unit is from April - September!
