



# a Virtual 5K Run/Walk for Wildlife...

## TIME & LOCATION

**Pick your time and location!** Choose to walk/run the course at BNC - we will have a map posted on our door through May 10 showing the course. Our trails are open from sunrise to sunset so you can pick the time you want to run! Can't make it to our trails, then choose a location near you or run on your treadmill - you will still be supporting our wildlife!

**Directions to BNC:** Take exit #73 off I-75, go west on St. Rt. 55, 2.4 miles, turn right onto Horseshoe Bend Road, 2.1 miles to BNC entrance on the right. Parking available in nature center lot.

## Pre-registration Event

### ENTRY FEE

**February 26 - April 4** (t-shirt included)

- \$25 per person for non members
- \$20 for BNC Members
- Or choose the 'no T-shirt' option, and deduct \$5 from your registration fee
- Must be postmarked by March 29 to receive a t-shirt or dropped in our drop-box by April 4.

**April 2 - April 20** (no t-shirt)

- \$20 per person for non members
- \$15 for BNC Members
- All registrations must be postmarked by Thursday, April 15 or dropped off by Tuesday, April 20

**COURSE** starts and finishes at the parking lot and winds through the woods along the trails. Steep hills and rough terrain involved but you can handle it! And the wildflowers are amazing!!

**MORE COOL INFO** - All proceeds from this event help support our wildlife programs! Bring a friend! Walkers are welcome! No pets allowed on Brukner Nature Center grounds - they scare our Wildlife Ambassadors.

**WILDLIFE** - BNC has over 50 live animals on display. Come meet some of our wildlife ambassadors after the race. BNC also operates a wildlife rehabilitation unit accepting native Ohio wildlife for care and rehabilitation. Last year we accepted over 1,700 wildlife rehab patients!

**WILDLIFE REHAB WISHLIST:** Disposable non-latex exam gloves (size M/L), dry erase markers, bath towels (please, no holes or frayed edges), Pedialyte (unflavored), Cheerios (plain), cottonballs, Timothy hay, fresh fruit & vegetables, moist & dry cat food, dry dog food, poultry starter (20% protein), poultry grower and finisher (16% protein), 1" coflex wrap, saline solution, He laundry detergent pods, dishwasher detergent pods, bleach, 30 gallon force flex trash bags, toilet paper, paper towels, live mealworms, live wax worms, hard-shelled nuts (acorns, walnuts, etc), black oil sunflower seed, mixed seed, gift cards to Meijer, Lowes, PetCo, and Tractor Supply.

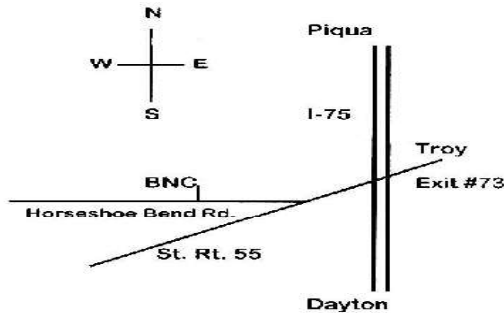
