TIME & LOCATION

Saturday, April 22, 2017 at 9:30am in the
Brukner Nature Center parking lot.

Directions: Take exit #73 off I-75, go west on St.
Rt. 55, 2.4 miles, turn right onto Horseshoe Bend
Road, 2.1 miles to BNC entrance on the right.
Parking available in nature center lot. **No one
can leave the parking lot until the race is
finished.** Please carpool!

REGISTRATION & CHECK-IN. Beat the rush
on race day morning and stop by Friday, April
21 from 5:00-6:30pm for packet pick-up and to
check out the course! Check-in on race day will
be held from **8:00 - 9:15am** only. There will be
no registration day of the race. **Entrance closes
at 9:15am and no one can enter after that!**



ENTRY FEE

**Registration must be postmarked by
Thursday, April 13 or dropped off by
5pm on Sunday, April 16.** Registration
fee is only \$25 per person (just \$20 for
Brukner Nature Center Members!) with
an eco-friendly short-sleeved T-shirt. If you
choose the 'no T-shirt' option, deduct \$5
from your registration fee. **This will be a
pre-registration-only event again this
year!** Be sure to send your registration in
before the deadline so you don't miss out
on all the fun!!

COURSE starts and finishes at the parking lot
and winds through the woods along the trails.
Steep hills and rough terrain involved but you
can handle it! And the wildflowers are amazing!!

STATIONS & FACILITIES - One water station
is located on the course. Split times will be given
at each mile. Restrooms are available inside the
nature center. Yummy food and entertainment
will be at the finish line. **Race will be run regard-
less of weather.**

AWARDS - Awards will be given after the race to
the top three males and females overall, and the
top two males and females in each age category!
Plus this year we'll have some fun eco-wildlife
prizes as well!

DOOR PRIZES - All participants are eligible for
door prizes and must be present to win. Prizes
will be given away before awards. **(Don't miss
these - they're wild! This year we have LOTS
of cool green giveaways!)**

**MORE COOL INFO - All proceeds from this
event help support our wildlife programs!**
Bring a friend! Walkers are welcome! No pets
allowed on Brukner Nature Center grounds - they
scare our Wildlife Ambassadors.

WILDLIFE - BNC has over 50 live animals on
display. Come meet some of our wildlife ambas-
sadors after the race. BNC also operates a wildlife
rehabilitation unit accepting native Ohio wildlife
for care and rehabilitation. Last year we accepted
over 1,400 wildlife rehab patients!

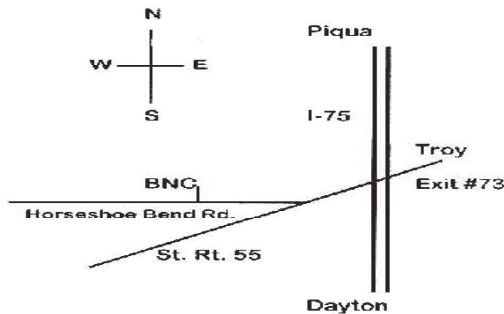
