Registration starts March 2, 2009 and closes 2 weeks prior to each camp. Payment must be received at the time registration closes in order to reserve your child's spot. We accept both check and cash. Space is limited so don't wait until the last minute to register! Cancellations with more than two weeks notice will receive a refund but are subject to a \$25 administration fee per request. Cancellations with less than 2 weeks notice will receive refund with a \$25 administration fee **only** if another camper fills the available spot.

Join Brukner Nature Center's Pre-school Environmental Education Program (PEEP) for wonderful hands-on experiences. These month long sessions offer classes on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday mornings from 9:30am - 11:30am and will focus on new topics and new outdoor experiences. There will be four week sessions for the month of June, July and August. Cost is \$35 for members and \$45 for non-members. Summer registration will take place on Sunday, April 26. Sunday hours at BNC are 12:30 to 5:00pm. Class size is limited to only 12 children so be sure to sign up early!

Summer PAWS

Register your curious kindergartner in this fun-filled outdoor exploration program. We investigate science and explore the outdoors while emphasizing the skills learned in the kindergarten classroom. Each class is filled with outdoor activities, crafts, games and stories all focused around the nature theme for the week. Small class size and a child-oriented classroom make learning fun! Class is open to children that have just completed kindergarten or will be entering kindergarten in the fall. There will be four week sessions for the months of June, July, and August. Cost is \$35 for members and \$45 for non-members. Classes will be held Monday mornings from 9:30-11:30 and afternoons from 12:30-2:30. Summer registration will begin Sunday, April 26th.
